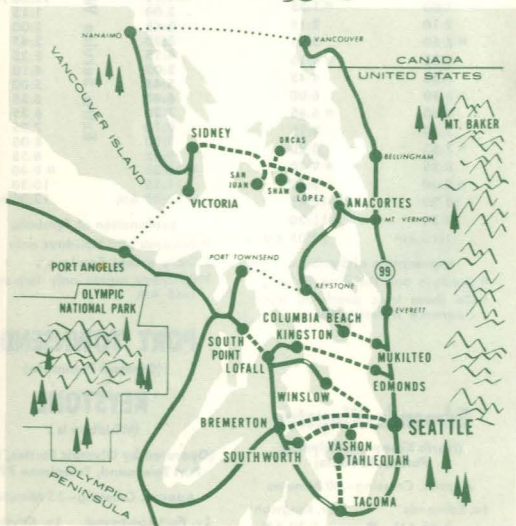

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

**RESERVATIONS**

Normally, there is ample space for vehicles aboard the vessels. Therefore Washington State Ferries does not accept reservations except from Lopez, Shaw, Orcas and Friday Harbor to Sidney. Upon arrival at the ferry terminal at Anacortes, consult our Agent as to details of such reservations.

**STOP-OVERS**

Certain free stop-over privileges are available as allowed by tariff regulations. Consult our Agent for particulars on arrival at ferry terminal.

**AUTO TRAILERS**

Auto trailers of any size generally can be handled over all of our ferry routes.

**PACIFIC STANDARD TIME**

Ferry time schedules of Washington State Ferries are based on Pacific Standard Time which is observed in the State of Washington.

**DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME**

British Columbia, Canada, observes Pacific Daylight Saving Time from the end of April through late September.

Note: Daylight time is one hour later than Standard time. For example the departure from Sidney at 6:30 A.M. P.S.T. is 7:30 A.M. Daylight saving time.

**COFFEE SHOP SERVICE**

Coffee shop service is provided on all regularly scheduled ferries except on the Point Defiance-Tahlequah route.
