BACKGROUND

 Although ample evidence has supported its preventative role in reducing the spread of COVID-19, mask-wearing has been stigmatized amidst the pandemic

AIMS

• Examine the relationship between stigma, mask-wearing, and mental health

METHOD

- Recruited participants via social media outlets
- 156 adults from the U.S.
- Data is from Wave 1 of a 12-wave, weekly, survey.
- Data analysis was a moderated mediation in *lavaan* (R)

Measures

- Mental Health
 - Positive and Negative Affect Schedule (PANAS; Russel & Daniels, 2018)
- Experienced Stigma
 - Adaptation of Perceived Language
 Discrimination Scale (Wei & Wang, 2012)
- Mask-Wearing
- Proportion of Others Wearing Masks

RESULTS


- There was a significant, negative effect of experienced stigma on mental health (both total and direct effects remained significant)
- The proportion of others wearing masks did not moderate the stigma → mask-wearing relationship
- Mask-wearing did not mediate the stigma
 —
 mental health relationship
