We are all O.K. Yesterday we got word from the school in Tokyo that their Dormitorys [sic] are full + that they wouldn't have room for Carol and Ruth. I don't know what we're going to do but trust that something can be worked out.

We had a cottage meeting this morning at Katsuta. Two new women have been attending quite regularly and we hope to reach many in that area. Jake + our pastor go out on Wed. and visit homes + invite people to come + pass out tracts. There are more than 500 homes built just by one company for their workers + we hold services in one of these homes where they are believers – They have a cute little girl 1 ½ years old who just loves Ruthie and calls her

is Aug. 9th.
