Jake went to Tokyo today with several of the pastors from this area. They are going to interview a new pastor who is interested in joining the F.M. Conference. Ruthie is home with me. She hasn't been feeling very well for 3 wks, not really sick but a little nauseated and no appetite. Monday I took her to Tokyo to an American Dr. He thought that it was just a lingering virus from a previous cold but gave her a complete physical. When we phoned on Wed. for the

report on the physical he said  
that her urine test showed the  
possibility of a kidney infection.
